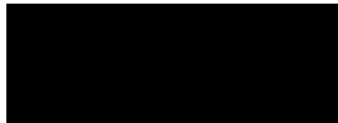

Proposed changes to your 2011 Form 1040

Amount due: \$115,845

We haven't received a response to the previous notice we sent you about your 2011 Form 1040. Since you didn't send supporting documentation as requested, we've determined you owe \$115,845 (including interest), which you need to pay by May 1, 2013.

What you need to do immediately

- If you can't pay the amount due, pay as much as you can now, and make payment arrangements that allow you to pay off the rest over time. If you want to apply for an installment plan, send in your Response form AND a completed Installment Agreement Request (Form 9465). Download Form 9465 from www.irs.gov, or call 1-800-829-3676 to request a copy. You can also save time and money by applying online if you qualify. If you don't agree with the changes

Complete the Response form on Page 7, and send it to us along with a signed statement and any documentation that supports your claim so we receive it by May 1, 2013.

If we don't hear from you

If we don't receive your response by May 1, 2013, we will send you a Statutory Notice of Deficiency followed by a final bill for the proposed amount due. During this time, interest will increase and penalties may apply.
