ORDER TO ENFORCE THE TERMS OF THE MARITAL DISSOLUTION
AGREEMENT

Petitioner, [REDACTED], commenced this action against Respondent, [REDACTED], by filing a Petition to Enforce the Terms of the Marital Dissolution Agreement. After hearing arguments for Petitioner and Respondent and through evidence presented by and through counsel for both parties, this Court finds that tax liens were filed against Respondent in 2010 and 2012 and that Respondent failed to pay his taxes to the Internal Revenue Service, which has interfered with Petitioner's ability to re-finance the mortgage on the marital property that was quitclaimed by Respondent pursuant to the Marital Dissolution Agreement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent shall pay to Petitioner \$29,720.26, which represents the assessed tax due by the Notices of Federal Tax Liens filed against Respondent on November 2, 2010 and on February 16, 2012. Respondent shall pay the amount owed in monthly payments of \$1,250.00 beginning on October 10, 2017 until the balance has been paid in full. The total amount payable by Respondent shall be reduced by \$4,500, which was paid by Respondent in this Court on September 21, 2017. Respondent shall no longer be obligated to pay Petitioner under this Order if the federal tax liens filed against Respondent

attached to [REDACTED] are removed. All costs in this matter are charged to Respondent.
